Employer-delivered classroom learning	Employer-led career learning		Employees enter the classroom to assist teacher in the delivery of traditional career learning activities
	Employer-led curriculum learning		Learning co-delivered by teachers and employers, employees linking curriculum to their own experiences
Enterprise Activities	Enterprise activities		Short-term enterprise activities delivered in schools that can involve simulation of business challenges
	Enterprise competitions		Longer-term business-run competitions where groups of pupil develop and run a small enterprise
